ORDINANCE NO. 4-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF DUNN RELATING TO TOWN PLANNING

Section 1: Plan Commission

(1) CREATION: Pursuant to Section 60.18 (12), 61.35 and 62.23 of the Wisconsin Statutes, there is hereby created a "Plan Commission" for the Town of Dunn, with the powers, duties and qualifications as set forth in this Ordinance and in Section 62.23 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

(2) MEMBERSHIP: The Plan Commission shall at all times consist of seven (7) members composed of six (6) Citizens of the Town and one (1) member of the Town Board.

(3) APPOINTMENT: The members shall be appointed by the Town Board.

(4) Term: The six (6) citizen members shall be appointed by the Town Chairman, subject to the approval of the Town Board, upon the creation of the commission, two of them each for periods ending 1, 2 and 3 years, respectively, from the succeeding first day of May, and thereafter annually during April two such members shall be appointed for a term of 3 years. Citizen members shall be persons of recognized experience and qualifications. The Board member of the commission shall be appointed by the Town Chairman, subject to approval by the Town Board, upon the creation of the commission, and during each April thereafter. The Board member shall serve only so long as he is a member of the Board. Whenever a vacancy shall occur in the term of any citizen or Board member, the Town Chairman shall appoint, subject to approval by the Town Board, a citizen or Board member to fill such unexpired term.

(5) OFFICERS: The members of the Plan Commission shall elect a Chairman and Secretary from among its membership.

(6) POWERS: The Plan Commission shall have the power and authority to employ experts (other than legal counsel) and a staff, and to pay for their services and such other expenses as may be necessary and proper, not exceeding, in all, the appropriation that may be made for such Commission by the Town Board, or placed at its disposal through gift, and subject to any ordinance or resolution enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Dunn.
