ORDINANCE NO. 16-1

VEHICLE STORAGE ORDINANCE

Section 1: Coverage

It shall be unlawful for any person to allow or permit the storage or parking of any unlicensed or inoperative motor vehicle, implement, commercial or industrial equipment or refuse, in or near any residential area in the said Town of Dunn.

Section 2: Notification

Any person who receives written notice from the Town Board of the Town of Dunn to remove from his property any such motor vehicle, implement, commercial or industrial equipment or refuse, shall have ten (10) days from the receipt of said notice to comply with same.

Section 3: Penalties

Any person who shall violate this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon arrest and conviction thereof shall forfeit the sum of \$1.00 for each day that said notice is not complied with. if said notice has not been complied with for a period of thirty (30) days from the mailing date of same, the Town Board may cause the said vehicles, implements, commercial or industrial equipment to be removed and said person shall bear the additional cost of removing same as a part of said forfeiture.
