ORDINANCE #11-7

**ORDINANCE CONTROLLING SALES OF  
CARRY-OUT SALES OF BEER AND LIQUOR**

Section 1: Restrictions Applicable to Opening and Closing  
Hours for Sale of Fermented Malt Beverages for  
Class A Licenses

No person shall sell or keep for sale or permit to be sold or kept for sale in or about any premises for which a Class A license has been issued any fermented malt beverage except in original unopened packages, containers or bottles, not to be consumed in or about the premises where sold. No fermented malt beverages shall be sold upon any premises for which a Class A license has been issued between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Further, between 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., no seller shall permit nor shall any person carry-out or remove from the Class A licensed premises any fermented malt beverages in an original unopened package, container or bottle or for consumption away from the premises.

Section 2: Restrictions Applicable to Sale or Carry-out of  
Fermented Malt Beverage from Class B Licenses

Between 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., no seller shall permit nor shall any person carry-out or remove from the Class B licensed premises any fermented malt beverage in an original or unopened package, container or bottle for consumption away from the premises.

Section 3: Restrictions Applicable to Sale or Carry-out of  
Fermented Malt Beverage from Class B Liquor  
Licenses

No intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverage in an original unopened package, container or bottle or for consumption away from the premises shall be sold or permitted to be sold between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Provided further, that between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m., no seller shall permit nor shall any person carry-out or remove from the Class B licensed premises, intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverage in an original unopened package, container or bottle or for consumption away from the premises.

Section 4: Penalties

Any person that violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof forfeit a sum of not more than

\$500.00 and upon failure to pay said forfeiture imposed shall be imprisoned in the county jail nor more than thirty days.
